




Quality Toast on Twitter

- 1. Shareholder demands require us to burn the toast.
- 2. Burnt toast is faster and cheaper to produce.
- 3. Burning the toast is inevitable, so we must become good at scraping.
- 4. Modern bread has become too complex know how it will toast.
- 5. Our toast isn't made in a factory.
- 6. Customers don't know how they want their toast.
- 7. Scraping makes us more Agile than toasting to order.
- 8. Scraping is part of our process and therefore value-added.
- 9. We are automating the scraping, so the cost will be minimal.




